Quartermaster/Adjutant notes:

The summer has been busy. We are closing out the Fiscal year, reporting out final audits, and submitting the final reports. We ended the 2022-23 year with 283 members and with several honors from the Department of Alabama and VFW National. The real work comes in the form of maintaining this new standard.

In this past year, we received a grant from All In Credit Union for \$26,000 to

build a Veterans Pavilion on the Post property. I anticipate the work will be complete in August. While we have submitted another grant request, the likelihood of a second grant back-to-back is unlikely. Therefore, it is necessary to republish the Post Board of Management's strategic plan. This plan should drive fundraising efforts outside of membership and Poppy drives. The grant request is for \$10,000. This is for the labor and materials to clear and create an archery range, a pistol range, a frisbee golf course, and complete the playground. Short Term (FY 2023-24):

- -Complete the All-In Veterans Pavilion no later than 1 September 2023 (fully funded)
- -Install a water Purification System (purchased by Girl Scout Troop 9048)
- -Install door thresholds (post-purchased)
- -Fix or replace riding lawnmowers and a push mower (damaged by rodents in a shed) New Life Member David Lowman volunteered for this effort.
- -Storage barn siding (self-help)
- -Replace solar sign light (self-help)
- -Replace kitchen sink faucet (post-purchased)
- -Repair women's toilet (self-help)
- -Replace bathroom toilet paper/paper towel dispensers (post-purchased)
- -Rebuild Playground (Donation from Milky Moo's former owner)
- -Finish clearing the front of the property (Quoted as part of the new All In Grant Submission)

Mid-Term (One-Three Years):

- -[1] New building roof and [2] old pavilion enclosing ("phase I") [now two separate projects]
- -BBQ Pit Improvement
- -Create a frisbee golf course (Quoted as part of the new All In Grant Submission)
- -Create a pistol range (Quoted as part of the new All In Grant Submission)
- -Create an archery range (Quoted as part of the new All In Grant Submission)

Long Term (One-Five Years):

- -Storage rooms and Stage
- -Upgrade driveway from dirt to compressed gravel
- -Level and gravel parking area
- -Explore connecting to city water and sewer

Post Service Officer Newsletter Submission, July 2023

Happy July, Comrades!

Under current law, a Service member whose service is cut short due to a disability, including combat related injuries/illnesses, is limited in their receivable compensation. A Bill introduced to Congress this past Spring aims to right this wrong.

Right now, to be eligible for both VA Compensation and Military Retirement, a retiree must have served 20 years AND have a disability rating of at least %50. The Major Richard Star Act would allow combat-disabled veterans with fewer than 20 years of service to collect retirement pay and VA compensation, without a reduction.

The bill's namesake, Army Major Richard Star, died in 2021 at the age of 51 from lung cancer suspected to stem from burn pit exposure in Iraq and Afghanistan. Star was medically retired and was a fierce advocate for disabled Veterans up until his untimely death.

If you, a family member, or a fellow Veteran was medically retired from Service prior to reaching full retirement eligibility due to a combat related injury/illness, please have them contact someone to see if they need assistance.
